SPICY GRAPE CAKE

1/3 C. margarine
1/2 C. each sugar & packed brown sugar
2 eggs
1/2 t. vanilla
1 1/4 C. flour
1 1/4 t. baking powder
1/2 t. each ground cinnamon and salt
1/4 t. each ground nutmeg and ginger
3-4 C. red, green grapes, halved & seeded

Cream margarine and sugars; add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each. Stir in vanilla. Combine flour, baking powder, salt and spices. Stir into creamed mixture, mixing well. Spread in greased 11-inch flan or 9-inch round cake pan. Arrange grapes over batter; sprinkle with Cinnamon Sugar Topping*. Bake at 350° for 45-55 min. or until cake springs back when lightly pressed. Cool 10 min., remove from pan. Serve warm with ice cream. Makes 8-10 servings.

* Cinnamon-Sugar Topping
Combine 1 T. sugar and 1/4 t. cinnamon
