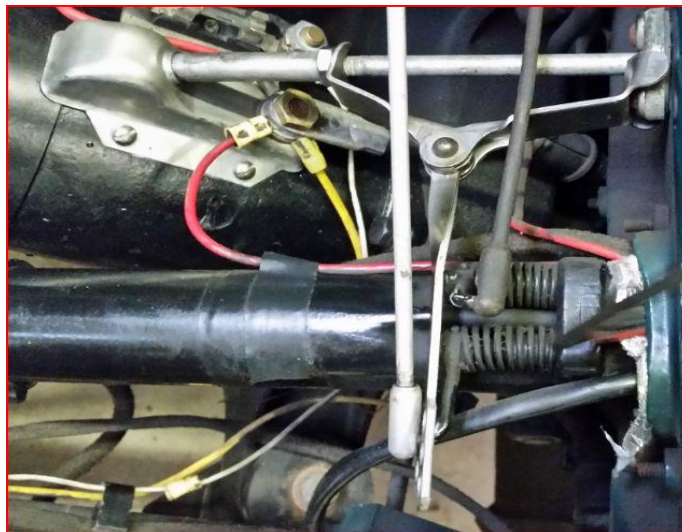
Board Meeting

What is it?

Have you heard of the word "**HOO-DYE**" for a part on the Model A Ford? This is the name that Ford has put on a part for the Model A Ford. What is a HOO-DYE? Where is it located? How many are there on a Model A Ford? What is the function? What is a "**Snubber**"? Where is it located? How many are there on a Model A Ford?

Last Month's "What is it?"



It is a "**Spark - Starter**". It is located on the starter, spark rod and up against the firewall. You turn your **Key** on, pull the **Throttle Rod** down **three notches** and push up on the **Spark Rod** and the engine will start. After the motor starts you pull the Spark Rod down three notches and push the Throttle Rod all the way up. You can also start the engine with the foot starter. With the Spark Rod Starter, no parts have to be removed from the car and you can still start your engine the original way. This is an aftermarket accessory for the ladies.
