Ladies, here are a couple of recipes from the Sullivan gals. We enjoyed these coffee cakes at the brunch before the Cob Web Tour on Saturday, April 12th.

Coffee Cake (Kathryn Sullivan)

Batter

1 pkg white or yellow cake mix
¾ c. oil
4 eggs
½ c. sugar
1 c. sour cream

Filling

4 T. brown sugar
¾ c. chopped nuts
2 tsp. cinnamon

Glaze

1 c. powdered sugar
2 T. milk

Mix batter ingredients altogether and beat.
Alternate ½ batter and ½ filling in a greased
9 x 13 or Bundt pan.
Bake @ 350 for 40 min.
Pour glaze over the cake while hot.

Orange Cranberry Pull-a-part (Linda Sullivan)

14 Rodes frozen rolls
1 lg orange (use rind (grated) from orange and save juice)
1 (3.4oz) pkg instant vanilla pudding
½ c. melted butter
¼ c sugar
A couple of handfuls of raisins

Glaze

1 c. powdered sugar
Juice from the orange
1 T. melted butter

Let rolls slightly thaw and cut into ¼'s. Place cut up rolls and raisins into a greased Bundt pan. Mix sugar and dry pudding mix and sprinkle over the rolls. Melt the butter and add zest from the orange. Pour over the top of the rolls. Cover w/ greased plastic wrap and set in the oven overnight (w/ the oven off). Remove the cake from the oven in the morning. Heat the oven to 350. Bake for 25 minutes. Take the cake out of the oven and flip over onto a plate. Make the glaze and drizzle over slightly cooled cake.
