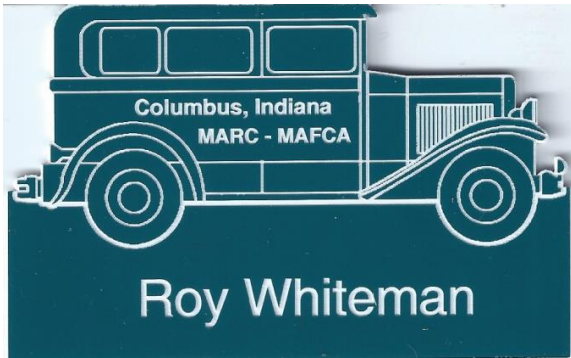
President's Corner

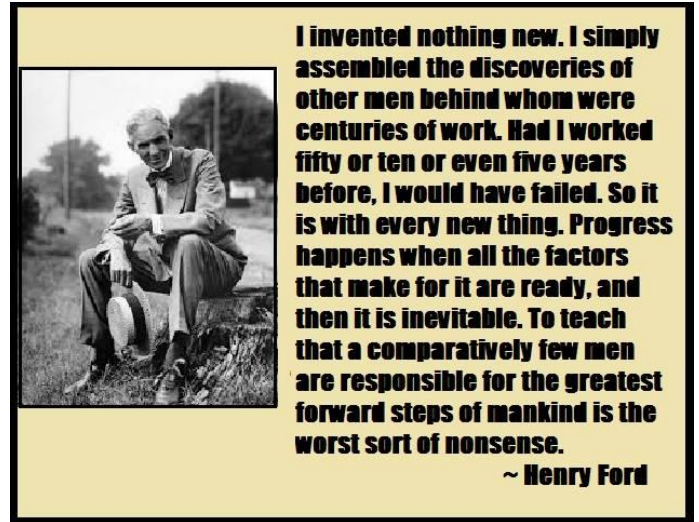

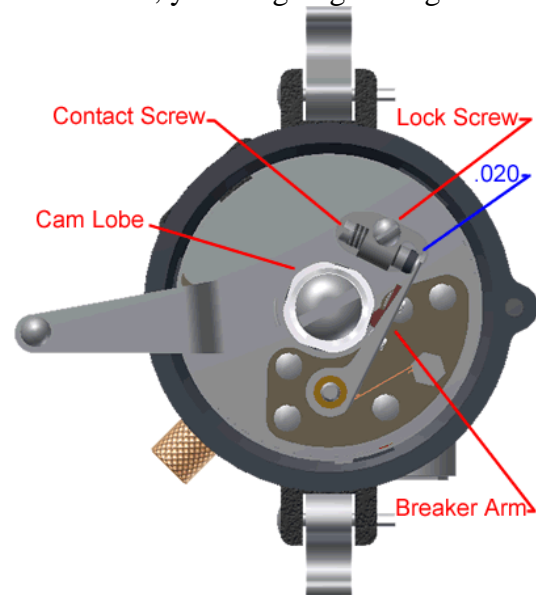

Per Indianapolis Service Letter dated Feb. 15, 1928

"HOO-DYE Arms & Fender Aprons:

In one or two instances, it has been reported to the Branch by dealer that the Hoo-Dye arms on the shock absorbers are striking and indenting front fender aprons. To eliminate this possibility, the dies have been changed to provide a greater sweep in the front fender apron which will give sufficient clearance to avoid the possibility of this damage. If your fender is damaged to the extent that you really feel it should be changed, please notify us. It might be well to set front snubbers one notch tighter."
