The first Model A was built. Henry Ford finally decided it was time to cease production of the Model T. A ceremony marked the formal end of the line in May 1927. The final total for Model T production was more than 15 million cars. On October 27, 1927, Ford Motor Company moved into a new era as the first Model A came off the Rouge assembly line.
