Hub City Model A Ford Club is hosting the National MARC Meet in 2017.

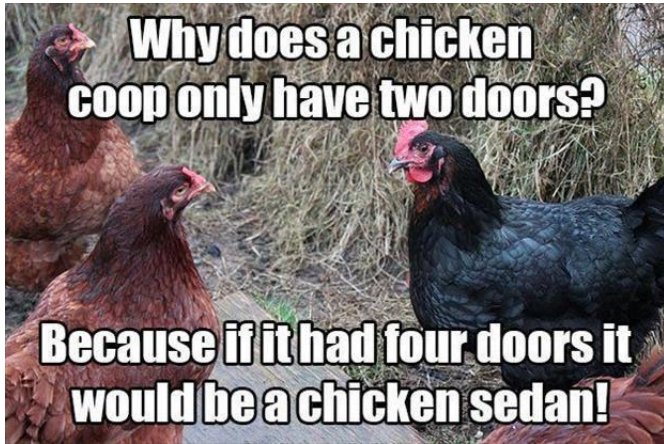

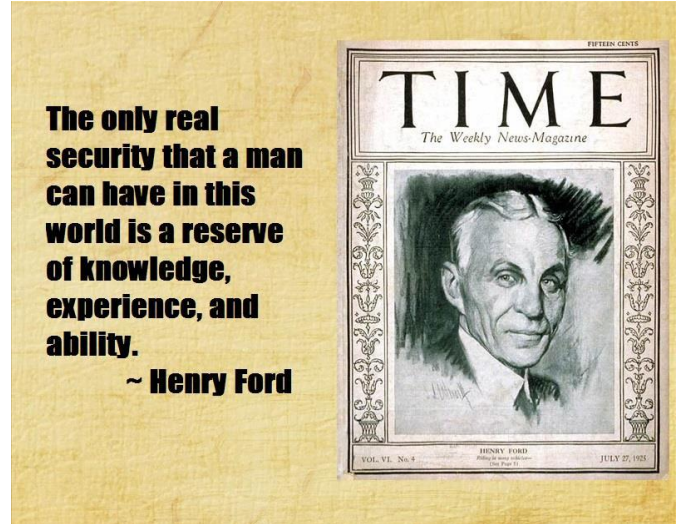

**Mt Vernon Overnight Trip (Larry Morlock)**

On the weekend of Aug 6 & 7, a group of us went to Mt Vernon to attend the Keck-Gonnerman Steam Meet and to see other sights in the “pocket” area of extreme southwestern Indiana, defined by the confluence of the Wabash and Ohio Rivers. The Keck-Gonnerman company manufactured steam engines and threshers in Mt Vernon from 1873 to the mid-1950’s.

We met on Saturday morning at McDonald’s in Bloomington to start the trip. Larry Morlock and Wayne Arnholt came from Columbus, Chris and Janice Rider plus Shelby came from Seymour, and met Pete & Deb Kloosterman, Ed & Mary Dathe, and Tim Ellis in Bloomington. We picked up Roy Whiteman when we passed his house on the way to I-69. Meantime, Dave & Wilma Evanczyk were making their way down I-64 from Utica to meet us in Mt Vernon, where Phil & Marge Sutton had already arrived the day before. George Titzer and Sarah Paul came from Evansville and we all converged on the Posey County 4-H Fairgrounds just in time for the lunch being served at the steam meet by the “Hawg-n-Sauce” restaurant – good barbecue. We had six Model A’s and one Mustang to display in an area set aside for us to park.

In the afternoon, we were able to see steam engines powering a sawmill and a wheat thresher, plus many other activities such as blacksmithing. There were also lots of old farm tractors to see. Some of our group went to nearby New Harmony to antique shop and then to the motel to relax and swim. In the evening, we ate on the banks of the Ohio River in Mt Vernon at the Bliss Restaurant.

After a garage tour at Phil & Marge Sutton’s there was a Euchre game and some more swimming, plus Larry & Wayne went back to the fairgrounds for the tractor pull.

After a leisurely breakfast on Sunday at the Four Seasons Motel in Mt Vernon, we toured Point Township. This included a visit to Hovey Lake with its many Cypress trees, the J. T. Myers Lock & Dam on the Ohio River in sight of the mouth of the Wabash River, and a nature walk to see a Cypress swamp from a raised wooden walkway. Point Township is the farthest north that Cypress trees grow in the US.

We had a nice Sunday lunch at the Red Geranium restaurant in New Harmony, then we all headed our separate ways back home. All the Model A’s ran fine the whole trip and we all enjoyed the companionship and fun that a Model A trip provides in abundance.
